The exhibit opening reception on Thursday, April 13th from 5:30pm to 7pm will feature the book, "Tractors, Trains, and Shipwrecks." It took several decades to bring the book's collection of vintage tales collected by Donald Richardson to fruition after his passing in 1983. The book has arrived in the museum gift shop and sells for \$18.99. Gaye LeBaron, leading historian, Press Democrat columnist, christened the book a "Tom Sawyer-like" account of his youthful exploits while growing up in the seaside hamlet of Stewarts Point.
